WELCOME MESSAGE





The Best Poster is an award for the best original scientific or clinical paper submitted by young surgeons in Malaysia for presentation at the Coloproctology 2012. This award will hopefully encourage a high standard of research and scientific presentations among young surgeons.

The Prize

There will be three(3) Best Poster awards:

1st Prize – RM 1, 000 2nd Prize – RM 750 3rd Prize – RM 500

Regulations

1. The competition is open to all young surgeons and surgical trainees currently working in Malaysian institutions, who are below 35 years old as on 1st January 2012.
2. The work submitted may be from any surgical specialty, and it may take the form of clinical trials, surveys, retrospective studies, laboratory experiments or any other form of unpublished original work.
3. The bulk of the work which are submitted must be performed by the author himself/herself even though he may have done the work in conjunction with other doctors or agencies either locally or overseas. However, the work must be carried out in Malaysia.
4. The author must submit a signed declaration of his/her age, that his/her paper has not been published or presented elsewhere and the presenter has done most of the work.
5. The abstracts for poster presentation is to be submitted online at **www.colorectalmy.org**.
6. The closing date for receipt of abstracts is **31st January 2012**.
